# ABOUT THE HOME BUILDERS FOUNDATION

THE HOME BUILDERS FOUNDATION PROVIDES OPPORTUNITIES FOR INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES WITH DISABILITIES TO ACHIEVE QUALITY OF LIFE AND POSITIVELY ENRICH THEIR COMMUNITY.

The Home Builders Foundation (HBF) provides home modifications at no cost for individuals with a physical disability. Each HBF project helps an individual remain at home with dignity and independence, improving the recipient's quality of life. HBF recipients typically fall into three categories: those with long-term physical disabilities, those with a spinal cord injury and those aging in place. The criteria for eligibility are: accessibility need, home ownership and location (the HBF serves the 8-county Denver metro area). To complete these projects the HBF partners with the home building industry and leverages resources to maximize money donated.
